

ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE

Community Name: Whitefish Township, County: Chippewa

Ordinance number 12032014

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Whitefish located in Chippewa County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Township of Whitefish ordains:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b (6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Zoning Administrator of the Township of Whitefish is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Whitefish under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Whitefish assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Chippewa County, Michigan" and dated 10/16/2014 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26033D; 0025D, 0050D, 0075D, 0100D, 0125D, 0150D, 0175D,

0200D, 0350D, 0375D, and 0400D and dated 10/16/2014 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

Section 4. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.

This ordinance duly adopted on December 3, 2014 at a special meeting of the Whitefish Township Board of Electors and will become effective December 7, 2014.
